At this stage we are running this as a pilot and a sniffer, to gauge the range and level of issues, and to assess the viability of turning it into something that can become more responsive.

Any follow-up e-mails will be kept strictly confidential, will only be used to inform the report writing, and will then also be destroyed.

You are welcome to recommend the IAU Division G ombud to any of your colleagues.
